Deuteronomy 18:15-20

15 I''The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers—it is to him you shall listen— 16 just as you desired of the Lord your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, I'Let me not hear again the voice of the Lord my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.' 17 And the Lord said to me, I'They are right in what they have spoken. 18 I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. IAnd I will put my words in his mouth, and I he shall speak to them all that I command him. 19 IAnd whoever will mot listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him. 20 IBut the prophet who presumes to speak a word in my name that I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that same prophet shall die.'

1 Corinthians 8:1-13

Now concerning! mfood offered to idols: we know that mall of us possess knowledge." This "knowledge" opuffs up, but love builds up. oglif anyone imagines that he knows something, the does not yet know as he ought to know. 3 But if anyone loves God, she is known by God.² ⁴ Therefore, as to the eating of food offered to idols, we know that <u>t</u>"an idol has no real existence," and that <u>u</u>"there is no God but one." ⁵ For although there may be <u>v</u>so-called gods in heaven or on earth—as indeed there are many "gods" and many "lords"— 6 yet wfor us there is one God, the Father, *from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and *uone Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and 2through whom we exist. 7 However, not all possess this knowledge. But some, athrough former association with idols, eat food as really offered to an idol, and btheir conscience, being weak, is defiled. 8 Food will not commend us to God. We are no worse off if we do not eat, and no better off if we do. 9 But take care 4that this right of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block 4to the weak. 10 For if anyone sees you who have knowledge eating in an idol's temple, will he not be encouraged,4 if his conscience is weak, to eat food offered to idols? 11 And so by your knowledge this weak person is destroyed, the brother for whom Christ died. 12 Thus, sinning against your brothers and qwounding their conscience when it is weak, hyou sin against Christ. 13 Therefore, if food makes my brother stumble, I will never eat meat, lest I make my brother stumble.
